

Parking for Mallarmé's November 1 Concert, "Young Felix"

Venue: University United Methodist Church, 150 East Franklin Street, Chapel Hill

Parking for those who find walking a distance difficult:

There are approximately 40 parking spaces at the UUMC. Come along East Franklin Street and just past Henderson Street on your right you will see the UUMC on your left. Just before the church with its tall white spire and white columns is a small driveway. Turn left into this laneway. On your left are 3 - 4 disabled parking spaces. If they are taken keep going along the laneway to the back of the church buildings and there are 30+ spaces back there. Lorna will be standing at the laneway entrance to direct you.

Other free Sunday parking spots which are in the same block and on the same side as the church:

1. The Porthole Lot behind the Carolina Coffee Shop
2. The lot behind the Ackland Museum
3. The Hill Building lot (access by turning left from Franklin St. onto Columbia and then the first left at Cameron which leads into the UNC campus. Turn left into the gated lot which will be free and open on Sunday)
4. The Planetarium lot. This lot is on Franklin Street, past Raleigh Street and the Chapel of the Cross. It is free on Sundays before 3 and after 6. If you park here and you leave before 6 pm there will be a small charge at the gate.
5. The parking deck off Rosemary Street is free on Sunday but there is no elevator and a lot of steps.
6. Open air lot on the corner of Rosemary and Columbia. This is free on Sunday and is only a very short walk to UUMC.
